Implement and scale social and emotional learning (SEL) supported by the personal and social general capabilities to support student's academic, behavioural, social and emotional capability development.

Implement the whole school approach to personalise learning through re-structuring school co-teaching practices: co-planning, co-teaching, co-reflecting and co-assessing across year levels and faculty areas. Providing focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support and intervention to demonstrate achievement against the year-level achievement standards.

Build teacher and support staff capacity in the classroom to plan and teach with a literacy focus using explicit and universally designed writing strategies to support instructional practices within Visible Teaching Visible Learning.
